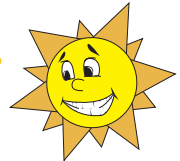

How do I Qualify:

For those Members that have an established handicap, handicaps will be frozen as of April 1st, 2010 for the event only. At that time, players will be designated a handicap bracket and team color (Black or Gold). Members will then attempt to qualify during any posted Qualifying week (see schedule below).

Qualifying Weeks:

Qualifying Week 5	August 9-15



Qualifying Entry:

The cost for a qualifying round will be \$10 + appropriate cart for each round played. Members can try to qualify as many times as they would like, as long as it is within a posted Qualifying week. Entries must be paid prior to the round and all qualifying rounds must be verified by at least one other playing partner.

Funds:

All funds raised throughout the Qualifiers will go toward team uniforms, food, etc. for the Memorial Cup October 9th and 10th. Each Member will also be assessed a small fee after making it to the finals to help cover the weekend's events.

Handicap Brackets:

The handicap brackets will be divided up accordingly to maximize competitive play. We will have two pre-assigned teams (Black & Gold). Members on either side will qualify for the designated spots below.
